

Community Council Meeting Minutes  
January 14, 2020

Attending: Michelle Pack, KayDe Hale, Angie Staheli, Yadi Call, Andrea Schmutz, Conley Gali, and Natalie Neva.

Excused: Jaime Kreyling, Warren Brooks, and Colleen Oberhansley.

Call to order by Andrea Schmutz.

Discussion:

- Review of the minutes from the meeting on November 12, 2019.
  - Yadi Call made a motion to approve the minutes and KayDe Hale seconded the motion.
- Review of anticipated amount of School Trustlands money and possible allocation for school year 2020-2021
  - We are projected to have \$151,825 to spend for the 2020-2021 school year. Mr. Hurt checked and that is the current amount we have to allocate.
- Discussion of course of action for determining disposition of funds in keeping with Utah law and rules applicable to School Trustlands funds:
  - The council went over each proposed expenditure from the November 12th minutes. Questions were addressed for each expenditure.
  - \$110,000 Salary for Two Teachers:
    - TSSA (from the November 12th minutes) was explained as “Teacher’s and Student’s Success Act.”
    - The Committee had been asked by Mr. Brooks to consider putting \$110,000 toward salaries for the next school year. Two teachers will need to be hired and this is a partial amount of what it would cost for the salaries for those teachers.
  - \$3,500 Piano Accompanist stipend
  - \$26,000 Two Part-Time Aids for the Wellness Room
    - Discussion was held about the benefits of the wellness room. Mr. Hurt will send the Council data on how the wellness room is being utilized at SCHS. Natalie Neva explained how, from a counselor’s perspective, the wellness room is benefiting students and will be better utilized as students come up to SCHS who have been trained in wellness rooms at other schools. The Council talked about how the wellness room can take the stigma out of talking about mental health issues. Mr. Hurt and Mr. Gali shared experiences where they have seen students improve because of the wellness room.
  - Fine Arts Chromebooks: The Fine Arts department has asked for a set of Chromebooks. Historically, a set of Chromebooks has cost around \$15,000. At this point, we will have \$12,325 to spend. Each year the school receives a bit

more money than had been anticipated. It was proposed that the \$12,325, and any extra we receive, be put toward a new set of Chromebooks for the Fine Arts Department.

- Voting
  - Angie Staheli motioned to accept the disposition of funds according to the above-mentioned plan. Yadi Call seconded the motion. Voting was unanimous.
- Next meeting
  - It was determined that there will not be a need for another meeting unless something arises which necessitates a discussion of an amendments to the approved allocation of Trustland Funds.
- Returning members
  - Michelle Pack, Angie Staheli, Yadi Call, and Andrea Schmutz are in their first year of their two year term. KayDe Hale, proposed Chairperson for 2020-2021 Council, will be up for re-election.
- Adjourn
  - KayDe Hale motioned to adjourn the meeting and Michelle Pack seconded the motion.

Meeting was adjourned until Fall of 2020 unless something arises which makes a February 11, 2020, meeting necessary.
